Arrive to sunny Florida via Miami International Airport for your first day of charter. Start with a short cruise around the Bay and along the Intercoastal Waterway to view the luxurious homes on Fisher, Star, Hibiscus and Palm Island. Embrace the experience that is South Beach with its cacophony of languages, array of ethnic restaurants, throbbing beat of the Latin music and dance the night away at one of the all-night clubs! On the way south, pass by Key Biscayne, where former USA President Nixon had his vacation house, and the legendary houses of Stiltsville. As the skyline of Miami disappears you will notice the low lying islands of the Florida Keys. Stop at Elliott Key (Biscayne National Park) or one of the reefs nearby, for a refreshing swim in the pristine water.

The secluded island of Key Biscayne, Florida, sits on the beautiful Biscayne Bay. Located south of Downtown Miami and north of Coconut Grove, Key Biscayne touts miles of golden sand beaches and quaint, quiet neighborhoods. Key Biscayne is a picturesque blend of low-key local flavor and relaxed tourist destination; it's the perfect place to unwind, relax and connect with one of Miami's best assets? Its natural beauty. The palm tree-lined streets and breezy island temperatures made Key Biscayne an ideal spot for building some popular attractions into the natural landscape. The Crandon Park Tennis Center is home to the Sony Ericsson Open tournament every March, and Crandon Park Golf Course's intriguing terrain puts it among the top 50 public courses in Florida. Tropical foliage lines the Key Biscayne road to Bill Baggs Cape Florida State Recreation Area, where the beach invites swimming or kayaking and the historic Cape Florida lighthouse is open for tours.

The first in the chain of the Florida Keys, Key Largo is one of the top diving areas in the US. Don your yacht's dive gear and explore the world's largest artificial reef, the huge shipwreck of the USS Spiegel Grove (over 500ft in length), and the extraordinary John Pennekamp Coral Reef Underwater State Park with its Christ of the Deep statue. Return to the yacht for cocktails on deck with views over mangrove forests.

The 'Village of Islands' boast the largest Florida Keys fishing fleet and one would guess that being dubbed the "Sport Fishing Capital of the World" makes that possible. Islamorada means "purple isles" and from a look around at the resorts and shops you can indeed see what they are talking about. The area has a focus on fishing but there are plenty of other things to do and see. Other activities include water sports, kayaking, jet skis, parasailing, boating and sunset cruises. There are some great waterfront restaurants that are worth a visit if you want to see some of the local color of Islamorada.

Marathon, Florida is considered the heart of the Florida Keys because of its location in the middle of the island chain. The area of Marathon consists of many Keys or islands starting with Long Key, the Conch Keys, Duck Key, Grassy Key, Boot Key, Crawl Key and Pigeon Key. Marathon is separated from the Lower Florida Keys on the south end by the Seven Mile Bridge. This bridge is famous and has been seen in many movies and is host to the Seven Mile Bridge Run each year. There are several excellent restaurants that serve fresh seafood and some good shops for visitors to purchase crafts from local artists. Marathon has some very nice communities including Key Colony Beach and Sombrero Beach.

Key West is a 90mile cruise from Miami, Florida. The laid back lifestyle, southern charm and Caribbean flavor are what make Key West what it is today. Dry Tortugas National Park is situated about 68 miles (109 km) west of Key West. The park is noted for abundant sea life, tropical bird breeding grounds, colorful coral reefs, and legends of shipwrecks and sunken treasures. Its centerpiece is Fort Jefferson, a massive but unfinished coastal fortress. Activities include snorkeling, picnicking, birdwatching, scuba diving, saltwater fishing and kayaking.
